

2019 LORCHER KAPELLENBERG TROCKENBEERENAUSLESE 99 RP

The Lorcher Kapellenberg is one of the Grand Cru sites of Lorch facing south. The vineyards are wind protected by the houses below, the village to the left and the forest above, and therefore the microclimate is warm and even. Steepness is less than 30%.

First mention of Lorcher Kapellenberg is 1480 ("hinter der Capelle" – "behind the chapel") St. Markus Chapel, dating back to 1364, but is no longer existent.

The soil is weathered grey slate, which results in a richer slate soil, additionally combined with loess, the soil is much richer than in the site Lorcher Krone.

The 99RP 2019 Lorcher Kapellenberg TBA combines a deeply textured fruit concentration, full of candied citrus fruits and pineapple, with a mineral finish.
