THE FESTIVAL


Sotheby's is delighted to introduce the **18th edition of the Festival Musique & Vin au Clos Vougeot**, a unique experience combining music concerts and wine tastings in a convivial atmosphere.

The festival, born of a partnership between Aubert de Villaine, Bernard Hervet, the Confrérie des Chevaliers du Tastevin, Domaine de la Romanée-Conti and Domaine Faiveley, once again brings together wine and musical excellence at the legendary Château du Clos Vougeot.

With the recommendations of their artistic advisors Gautier Capuçon and Jean-Yves Thibaudet, and thanks to the support of generous patrons and partners, the festival continues its commitment to supporting promising young artists alongside the greatest names in the musical world.

The 18th Edition of the festival will be held from **Saturday, June 20 to Sunday, June 28, 2026**. During these eight days, Musique & Vin au Clos Vougeot embodies the unique vocation of creating a fusion between musicians of international fame and the wine producers of Burgundy.

THE INSTRUMENTAL FUNDS

This fund **supports young musicians** who do not yet have the financial means to acquire a high-quality instrument.

From the very beginning of the festival, Bernard Hervert and Daniel Weissmann, encouraged by Aubert de Villaine, sought to support young artists who did not yet have access to quality instruments. They therefore founded the **Instrument Fund of Musique & Vin au Clos Vougeot**, primarily **financed through auction sales**.

This unique initiative pays tribute to the prestigious vineyards of Burgundy through the creation of string instruments, each bearing the name of one of the thirty-three Grand Crus. Examples include the 2014 Günter Siefert violin "Corton-Charlemagne," the 2012 Patrick Robin cello "La Tâche," and the 2013 Claude Macabrey viola "Montrachet."

Each instrument also bears a vintage label, "Musique & Vin au Clos Vougeot." Today, **the fund includes more than 29 violins, violas, and cellos**, and continues to grow through instruments loaned by private individuals.

THE AUCTION

In parallel with this music festival, Sotheby's is delighted to renew its collaboration with Musique & Vin au Clos de Vougeot to arrange an **extraordinary online auction**, offering rare bottles donated directly by the most prestigious domaines of Burgundy and beyond, as well as remarkable experiences. This unique opportunity to acquire superb bottles will support the Instrumental Fund and finance scholarships and concerts for young talents, enabling them to practice their art in the best possible conditions.

Bidding will open on **June 15, 2026, at 2:00 PM CEST**, culminating in an online 1-minute closing on **June 30, 2026, at 2:00 PM CEST**.

Please note that, for each lot, a Buyer's Premium of 7% and Overhead Premium of 1% will be applied to the hammer price.

WHAT TO DO AROUND BEAUNE?

Château du Clos de Vougeot

Located in the very heart of Burgundy's vineyards, the castle was originally a wine farm, built in the 12th century by monks from the nearby Abbey of Cîteaux. Even though the Chateau du Clos de Vougeot does not produce wine anymore, it stays the symbol of a millenium of Burgundy's History and is today the headquarters of the Association des Climats de Bourgogne.



Cité des Climats et Vins de Bourgogne

The Cité des Climats et vins de Bourgogne in Beaune is home to the main interpretation centre for Bourgogne's vineyard Climats. Within the visitor trail, a space is dedicated to this model of *terroir*-based viticulture, the historic cradle of which is the Côte d'Or, but which shines throughout Bourgogne.

Musée de l'Hôtel-Dieu, Hospices de Beaune

The history of the Hospices Civils de Beaune began in 1443 with the construction of the Hôtel-Dieu. Today, the building is a museum with an exceptional architectural and artistic heritage that reflects the richness of Burgundy.
